## **CITY OF LEBANON—NOVEMBER 3, 2020**

### **The Qualifying deadline for Candidates is NOON—August 20, 2020**

Notice is hereby given that on November 3, 2020 there will be a City of Lebanon Election for the purpose of electing a Mayor, Alderman-Ward 1, Alderman-Ward 2 & Alderman-Ward 5. They must meet general qualifications set out in TCA 8-18-101, be a qualified voter of the city and reside within the city for 1 yr. preceding the election.

## **CITY OF MT. JULIET—NOVEMBER 3, 2020**

### **The Qualifying deadline for Candidates is NOON—August 20, 2020**

Notice is hereby given that on November 3, 2020 there will be a City of Mt. Juliet Election for the purpose of electing a Mayor, Commissioner-District 1, Commissioner- District 3 and District 4 (2-year term). Candidates must meet general qualifications set out in TCA 8-18-101, be a qualified voter of the City of Mt. Juliet and not have violated any provisions in TCA 6-20-108.

## **CITY OF WATERTOWN—NOVEMBER 3, 2020**

### **The Qualifying deadline for Candidates is NOON—August 20, 2020**

Notice is hereby given that on November 3, 2020 there will be a City of Watertown Election for the purpose of electing a Mayor and Three (3) At-Large Alderman members. Candidates must meet general qualifications set out in TCA 8-18-101, be a qualified voter of the City of Watertown, at least 21 years of age and reside within the city for 1 yr. preceding the election.

## **CARTMELL SCHOLARSHIP—NOVEMBER 3, 2020**

### **The Qualifying deadline for Candidates is NOON—August 20, 2020**

Candidates for the Cartmell Scholarship must be residents of the City of Lebanon or the 3<sup>rd</sup> Civil District. The funds for this scholarship are administered by Vanderbilt University and shall be used only at that institution. Only voters eligible to vote in the City of Lebanon Election will be allowed to vote for the scholarship recipient.

To Qualify, candidates shall file their original petition in the County Election Office where they reside by the Qualifying Deadline. The nominating petition must be signed by at least twenty-five (25) voters who are registered in the candidates' district/ward. Petitions may be picked up at the Election Commission Office located at 203 East Main Street, Lebanon, TN 37087 Monday-Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

## **VOTERS WITH DISABILITIES & ELDERLY VOTERS**

Pursuant to section T.C.A. § 2-3-109 (E) Notice is hereby given that voters with disabilities or elderly voters (persons 60 or older) assigned to vote in precincts where the polling place is inaccessible may vote at the Wilson County Election Commission office on election day OR vote early by personal appearance during the dates specified for early voting at the election commission office OR vote by absentee ballot. Any voter with a disability or elderly voter desiring to vote at the election commission office must notify the office in writing and complete an affidavit that states their voting location is inaccessible. Deadline for notification is October 24, 2020. Affidavits are available at the election office. To vote an absentee ballot by-mail, the voter must make the request in writing and include their name (as registered), social security number, date of birth, residence address (911 address), mailing address (if different from residence address), the election(s) they wish to vote in, the reason they are requesting to vote an absentee ballot and their signature. The written request must be received by mail not later than October 27, 2020. Requests must be mailed to The Wilson County Election Commission office, P. O. Box, Lebanon, TN 37088. If you are voting during the Early Voting period, remember to bring identification with you. **A voter must have a federal government or Tennessee State issued photo ID.** If no photo identification is provided, the voter will vote a provisional ballot and the voter will have two business days after the election to return to the election commission office and show a valid photo I.D. or the ballot will be rejected. The voter can sign an oath stating he/she is indigent or an oath stating a religious objection to being photographed. **Forms of acceptable identification include a Tennessee Driver's License with your photo, United States Passport, Tennessee State Department of Safety photo ID, Photo issued by the federal or Tennessee state government, United States Military photo ID or Tennessee gun permit with your photo.** The Election Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability.
